# Overview

- Consultation published 17 March /closing date 26 May
- Covers all PSPS - no requirement to respond to every question
- Current codes of practice:
  - Separate and discrete
  - Outdated and duplicated
  - Inconsistent expectations
  - Ease of navigation
- Opportunity to clarify and modernise code
- Interactive web based code
- New expectations – ‘effective system of governance’

# Modular Code Consultation

- Modular code consultation:

- 51 modules replacing 10 (of 15) existing Codes of Practice – including Code of Practice 14
- New Code covers five key areas:
  - Governing Body
  - Funding and Investment
  - Administration
  - Communication and Disclosure
  - Reporting to TPR
- Phased transition

# Presentation of Expectations

- Current CoP difficult to find
- New code – fresh approach
  - Expectations appear in lists
  - Lists separate legal duties and expectations of how funds should meet them
- Adopted gov language:
  - Must = legal duty
  - Should = expectation
  - Need = no legal requirement or expectation but process necessary to operate effectively

# ‘The Governing Body’

- New term to provide consistency
  - The Governing Body – collective term
- Single term such as ‘trustee’ disengaging
- No LGPS Specific version of the code

  - Cyber security
- Own Risk Assessment
- ESG:
  - Stewardship – governance responsibilities
  - Climate change – risk and opportunities
